Courtney began his career in the field of municipal administration. After training in Hudson Bay, Saskatchewan he worked as Town Administrator for communities including Watrous, Canora, and lastly, Warman. While working as an administrator, he pursued his goal of an accounting designation, which he achieved in 1986, when he was conferred a Certified General Accountant designation from CGA Saskatchewan.
