

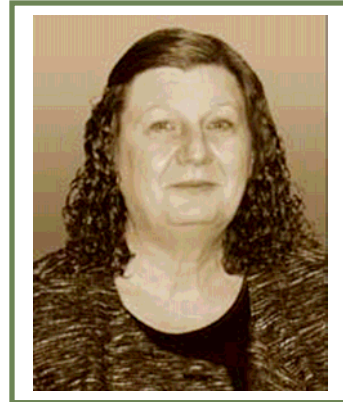


## **Olchowski named Woman of Influence by Saskatchewan Business Magazine.**
